## PS - Home Learning - Maths

Following on from the work we have been doing in class recording amounts – I would like for you to find some toys, count them and then create marks (e.g. circles or lines) to record the amount on a piece of paper or white board (e.g. 3 lines to represent 3 toy cars). We have found that counting out loud helps us to stop at the correct amount. Then choose a different type of toy or object to count and record these. Remember how we have been drawing pictures to help us see what we have been counting? Have a go a drawing the different objects you have been counting by your marks so you can recount the marks you have made.
