A Wonderful World: Appreciating God's Creations Year - Pre School



Throughout this focus children will be exploring and developing their understanding of friendship, making relationships and demonstrating friendly behaviour.

They will begin to develop an understanding of their own feelings and those of other people. Through this they will also begin to develop an under-standing of how their actions can affect other people.

Through Understanding the World children will begin to think and talk about what makes them unique and talk about the similarities and differences in relation to friends and family.

Theme Impact

Children will gain an understanding of the need to be friendly and develop relationships with other children and adults, and how their actions can have an impact on other people.

Catholic Social Teaching

The Church believes that work is important as it is a way to take part in God's creation. This means that working conditions must respect the rights of workers, and that the conditions that people work in are fair and that people are happy.

Application

Children to gain an understanding of how to be friendly and how they can make friendships, through talking about and demonstrating what makes a good friend, and putting what we have talked about into practice. Children will also create gifts in the form of bracelets for their chosen friend and draw pictures of the friend as a portrait.
